PREPARING FOR CHRISTMAS

My two little boys, Boaz and Jakin, have been excited about Christmas since roughly the minute Boaz' last birthday presents were opened in October. Jakin has been saying, "It's Christmas Mommy and Daddy!" at random times, and we think it's his way of indicating that something needs to be celebrated. Now, I recognize that my sons are really just looking forward to the next time they get to open presents . . . but I have decided that this year I want to take advantage of their anticipation. This year, I want to get an Advent calendar.













I don't remember my family ever having an Advent calendar. Obviously, even if we did, it didn't make much of an impression on me. Now, I love Christmas—Christmas carols, Christmas movies, Christmas food, the Christmas story, Christmas Eve service (and/or Christmas Day service)—I love them all. But for this Christmas, I want to focus on preparation—my personal and my family's heart-readiness for this season.

That's where the Advent calendar comes in. An Advent calendar is a way of celebrating Christmas, the birth of Jesus, for more than just the 25th of December. It was originally created to give Christians a chance to prepare their hearts for this important season. It has been adopted primarily for children, both to harness their excitement about Christmas and to help them understand the real meaning behind the holiday. But its primary purpose remains to help with preparing for celebrating the birth of Jesus.

Let me ask you. Are you prepared for Jesus' birth? His birth literally split time . . . all our dates are referenced by this pivotal moment . . . before and after His birth. The most important question in the world is, "Who do you say that I am?" (Matthew 16:15). As my sons start to understand Christmas and all the fun it represents (Presents! Lights! Vacation!), I want them to understand the real meaning behind it. It seems simple to add an Advent calendar to our lives, but I am excited about exploring the birth of Jesus in a deeper and more meaningful way.

When Jesus came to Earth as a baby, He gave up His divinity, His power and His status to become part of a hated and despised race. Philipians 2:7 describes this very well. "Rather, He made Himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness." I want to understand this in a deeper and more tangible way, and I want my sons to start to grasp the miracle represented by a song like *Away in a Manger*. So, we will be using an Advent calendar this year. But more than just enjoying the chocolate, scriptures and fun pictures in our calendar, we will be preparing our hearts for Christmas. So, are you prepared for Christmas? 🎁

GOOGLING GOD

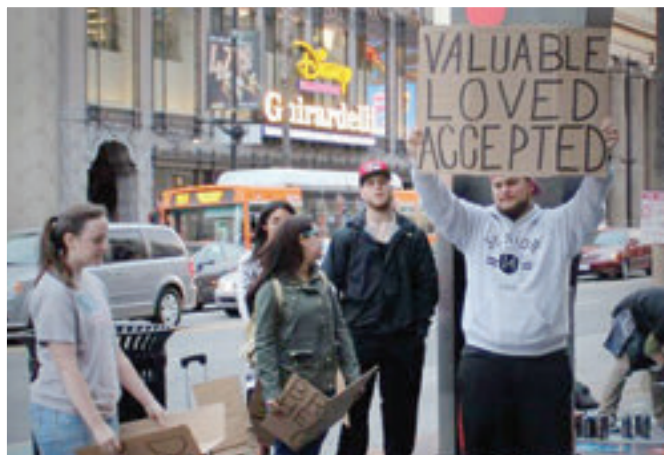
Everyone knows the Internet uses the World Wide Web. The Internet connects millions of computers globally, forming a network where any computer can communicate with any other computer, as long as they are both Internet-connected. The Internet is invaluable for gathering information. There are over 1 billion websites on the Internet. A single Google query uses 1,000 computers in 0.2 seconds to retrieve an answer. There are up to 500 million tweets sent per day, and 100 billion emails each day. Over 6 million hours of video are watched every month on YouTube—that's almost one hour

for every person on the Earth. Connections are vitally important in life.

God has an invisible and supernatural system for networking. I have learned that God has the power and ability to create Divine appointments for connecting people. This worldwide web (WWW) could be known as God's "miracle magnet maze" or the MMM. God brings people together to bless them and to build His Kingdom. One of CFN's Twelve Foundational Pillars is the Pillar of Relationships. This Pillar is about using God's power to connect and facilitate the Great Commission.

CONNECTING WITH OTHER DENOMINATIONS

My parents were always open to working alongside any and all believers, even if they weren't full gospel believers. When I speak of relationships, I am not talking about creating relationships with others where you work, at church or for recreation, but with those who are not of our church or faith persuasion, who love the Lord, are following Him and may want to fellowship with us.

STEPPING OUT OF ONE'S DENOMINATIONAL BOX

Dad worked with over 100 ministries in the early years of Christ For The Nations. He and Mom were always open to other churches, denominations and ministries that were not Pentecostal or Charismatic. Sometimes these ministries just wanted fellowship and were open to meeting with us or having us minister to their congregations. CFN has grown and advanced

because it has promoted participation with other denominations and Christian camps of belief who became hungry for a more in-depth understanding of God, His giftings and were willing to step out of their comfortable 'box setting' to fellowship with us, even though they may have been cautioned to keep their distance. As a result, deep friendships were developed and relationships grew. Over time, God provided Divine contacts, connections and encounters with others who have blessed CFNI with their support, prayers and financial assistance.

CHARLATANS AND HEAVYWEIGHTS

It's true, some ministers have turned out to be charlatans, while others became heavyweights in the Christian community and the Kingdom of God. Dad would share their miracle testimonies and advertise their ministries and upcoming revivals in our monthly magazine. Some of these individuals tried to take over the CFN ministry.

These ministers and their ministries have come and gone, but the foundation that Dad laid is still alive and well and is far greater in its extensive efforts of world evangelism than even he could have imagined.

SOUTHERN BAPTIST, METHODIST, EPISCOPAL AND CHARISMATIC CATHOLIC MINISTRIES

We enjoyed having Dr. W. A. Criswell from the First Baptist Church in Dallas as a commencement speaker. When he graduated to Heaven, his successor, Dr. Robert Jeffress, also spoke at our commencement. We have enjoyed fellowshiping with Southern Baptist, Methodist, Episcopal and even Charismatic Catholic ministries. We have even invited a few non-believers, like the former Jewish mayor of Dallas, to share with the students as she had become aware of the positive influence our students were making in Dallas. At the conclusion of her address, a student gave a message in tongues and the interpretation. CFNI leadership held their breath, but the interpretation was a Divinely anointed word from God.

During the 90s, Dr. Harold Reents was involved in higher education in the Catholic Church and was filled with the Holy Spirit. He came to CFNI to receive. Mom became acquainted with his proficiency and leadership and invited him to serve on staff. In time, Dr. Reents became the Academic Dean and the Director of the Institute, where he and his wife, Patty, served for many years.

"NOT ONE OF US"

Years ago, one of our Institute leaders decided our students should not work with a couple of churches in the Dallas metroplex who didn't agree with our ministry. When I found out about this, I sent the leader a memo stating that if these ministries wanted to labor with us we would not separate ourselves from them.

As it turned out, by maintaining these friendships, our ministry has been blessed with favor and monetary gifts. I have witnessed

the blessings of the Lord by maintaining an open heart toward any ministry that will allow us to serve them in any way. Throughout the years, a number of ministries have asked to use our students for various projects and conferences they were hosting.

This past summer we were invited to be at Bishop T.D. Jakes' church, The Potter's House, for the three-hour memorial service in honor of the five policemen who were slain in Dallas. After the worship service, I was invited onstage, and for 15 minutes, Christ For The Nations was honored for its service to Dallas, the community and The Potter's House. CFN was the only ministry recognized with an estimated half a million TV watchers. Only God could have arranged this advertising appointment.

THE "APPOINTED AND ANOINTED" GROUP

I'm reminded of the argument among the disciples about who was the greatest; a related dispute also arose. John, the Lord's "beloved," told Jesus that a certain individual was ministering in His name who was not part of their group—those who were "appointed and anointed" (Luke 9:49). Jesus responded, "Don't hinder the individual who is working for God." Apparently, the individual was working alongside of Christ and was doing well

"Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of His return is drawing near" (Hebrews 10:24, 25).

with fellowmen, weakening Satan's kingdom. Jesus forbade the disciples from being critical of this individual in his good work of faith.

Christ For The Nations sees these ministries and individuals, that we may not be in partnership with, as doing the work of our Lord. Jesus perceived the individual to be a man of faith, not a competitor or a counterfeit. Today, we need the Holy Spirit in order to be discerning, and to be like our Lord, Who saw the grace of our Father at work in fulfilling the Great Commission.

HIS NAME SHALL BE CALLED

When Jesus calmed the storm on the Sea of Galilee, His disciples looked at one another with amazement and said, “What manner of man is this that even the winds and sea obey Him?” (Matthew 8:27). Since that day, people have still been asking that question, “What manner of man is this?” Regardless of what people may think of Christ, they must admit that the impact He made on the world is the greatest of any person who has ever lived.

Jesus came on the scene quietly and almost unannounced. The town He was brought up in, Nazareth, was regarded as most insignificant, a place scarcely mentioned by historians. The words spoken by Nathaniel when he first heard of Jesus, “Can any good thing come out of Nazareth?” give some idea of what people thought of the village. In His lifetime, He never acquired any property of His own. He was born in a manger borrowed from animals; He preached from a borrowed boat; He slept in a borrowed bed; He rode into Jerusalem on a borrowed beast; He served the Passover in a borrowed room; He was buried in a borrowed tomb. *Only the cross was His own.*

The Man who was born in the stable in Bethlehem is the one around whom all events of history are dated. Not only the followers of Christ, but the infidel, the skeptic, the rich man, the poor man—all have one

thing in common—they take note of the date of Christ’s birth every time they look at a calendar. It only proves that He was more than a mere man.

HE WAS TO BE BORN OF A VIRGIN

Eight centuries before Jesus was born, the prophet Isaiah predicted: “Behold a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call His name Immanuel” (Isaiah 7:14).

That is exactly what took place. The angel Gabriel appeared to the Virgin Mary and told her that she would be with child by the Holy Ghost (Luke 1:26-38). Christ was the only person in the world Who was born of the Holy Spirit, rather than of the will of man.

THE PLACE OF HIS BIRTH WAS FORETOLD

Micah, the prophet writing 500 years before the birth of Christ, shared a verse that is recognized as describing Jesus’ birthplace. He said that the Son of God, Who had existence previous to His earthly birth, was to be born in Bethlehem: “But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for Me One who will be Ruler over Israel, Whose origins are from of old, from ancient times” (Micah 5:2).



HIS DEATH WAS PREDICTED

There is another remarkable thing about the Messiah, found in Daniel's prophecies. Daniel 9:26 says that the Messiah was to be "cut off, but not for Himself." Rather than setting up a visible kingdom at His first coming, Daniel foretold that He was going to die!

Even the kind of death the Messiah would experience was predicted by the psalmist David, 900 years before it happened: "Dogs surround me, a pack of villains encircles me; they pierce my hands and my feet" (Psalm 22:16). What an amazing picture of the cross!

HE TOOK POWER OVER DEATH

Many great men have lived and died, and their bones still lie in their graves. Only in one place in the world is there an empty tomb: in Jerusalem, at the foot of Calvary where they laid the Lord Jesus. It was three days later that the angel said, "He is not here; He is risen" (Matthew 28:6). Jesus said that the sign of Jonah should be given to that generation (Matthew 16:4). "For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of a huge fish, so the Son of Man will be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth" (Matthew 12:40). It was this incontestable victory over death that gave the apostles power to be a "witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus" (Acts 4:33).

HE FORGAVE SINS

Sinners loved to be near Christ, not because they felt at ease in their sins, but because in Him they saw a cure for their malady. The woman at the well felt her soul laid bare when Jesus said, "The fact is, you have had five husbands, and the man you now have is not your husband" (John 4:18). Yet she saw hope and forgiveness in the very One Who had called attention to her sinful past. Her testimony to her neighbors carried such conviction that they also came and believed "that this is indeed the Christ, the Savior of the world" (John 4:42).

CHRIST GIVES A PERSONAL EXPERIENCE TODAY

When Christ comes into our life, He makes us a new creature; He takes away our burden of sin and brings peace into our hearts. Some may argue against Christianity, but they cannot argue against the experience Christ gives. The Christian's personal experience with Christ is the greatest proof of His reality. He truly fulfills in our lives the words of the prophet Isaiah: "For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given, and the government will be on His shoulder. And He will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace" (Isaiah 9:6). 🕊

He was set FREE

aj Mugalkhod was born on the streets of the red light district in Kamathipura, Mumbai, India. His mother, only a teenager when he was born, was a seventh-generation temple prostitute. She had been given to the goddess Yellamma, so she would never be allowed to marry a mortal. Even though she maintained a relationship with her four sons' father for short periods of time, Raj's mother had to continue her life as a temple prostitute and struggled to care for her four boys, as well as her four orphaned nieces.

While his mother was doing the best she could, like many children born into severe poverty, Raj had to fend for himself from a very young age. He often had to resort to begging when he could find no work. Hunger was a fact of life, as were serious illnesses including hepatitis, malaria and typhoid fever. Just to survive, he joined a gang, engaging in criminal behavior. This bothered his sensitive conscience, which then led him to alcohol addiction, and the cycle of misery continued.

Raj grew up in a brothel, and in this unsafe environment he was sexually abused many times from the age of eight. He also saw others abused and trafficked, and this caused him to despair. At the age of 16, he had seen enough and attempted to escape his miserable existence by taking poison. For seven days, he lay in a coma with the doctors giving his

mother little hope of his survival. She was not one to give up easily, and she contacted a Christian pastor, who fasted and prayed for Raj's life.

While lying in a coma, Raj remembers being pulled down toward Hell by demons, only to have Jesus appear. Jesus reached out His hand and pulled Raj out of Hell. After that near death experience, Raj was never the same. For the next 20 years, he invested his life in full-time Christian service, rescuing the victims of human trafficking in the district where he grew up. He rescued over 100 women and girls, often using his own money to purchase their freedom.

In April 2009, Raj married a beautiful Christian woman named Mansi, and shortly after they became pregnant. At the time, Raj was involved with the production of a groundbreaking documentary on human trafficking, *The Cage*. As was customary in India, Mansi returned to her parent's home for the delivery. Unfortunately, Raj only got to see Mansi and their new son Mark for one day, and then he had to return to work on the project. He was soon notified that Mansi had complications and caught a train to be with her. Tragically, Mansi passed away early the next morning, only 15 days after bringing Mark into the world.

Raj struggled with survivor's guilt; he was devastated and temporarily lost the use of his legs, probably due to severe shock and grief. He had to

take a break from work to recover both physically and emotionally while his mother, who had become a Christian after seeing Raj's deliverance, graciously stepped up to care for his new son. At this point Raj had no interest in remarrying, but he threw himself into the work of rescuing victims of trafficking. Since he had very little formal education, God gave him a desire to study and prepare for the high school equivalency test. Even though he had to teach himself, he miraculously passed. He attended South Asia Bible School for a year, which also couldn't have happened without Divine assistance.

After faithfully serving with Teen Challenge for many years, God put a vision in Raj's heart to further his education at Christ For The Nations Institute in Dallas, Texas. CFNI gave Raj a Full-work Scholarship,

enabling him to pursue this vision. The April before Raj embarked on this epic venture, he was advised by spiritual mentors, Samuel and Shalini Daniel, that he needed a wife for himself and a mother for Mark. Raj contacted Anita, his deceased wife's sister, with a proposal of marriage. Anita had kept her faith secret because her parents were devout Hindus and blamed both Raj and his God for the death of their daughter. At the time, she had already been proposed to by a Google engineer who could offer her all the material things Raj could not. There was one very important thing he lacked: faith in Jesus Christ. After three days of praying and fasting, Anita accepted Raj's proposal, and they were married one week later. Anita's parents told her that she was no longer

their daughter. She had to leave home with nothing but her faith in God and her new husband and son. (Anita is continuing to believe for her parents' salvation and loves them dearly.)

Seeing the call of God on his life, Raj's friends rallied around his dream and gave him the money to travel to America to attend CFNI. The miracles of provision continued as soon as Raj and Anita arrived in America. When they arrived at the airport, they only had one dollar, and no one would let them use their cell phone or give them change for a dollar to call someone for a ride to CFNI. In desperation, Anita bowed her head and prayed to God for help. When she looked up, she saw a dark-skinned man walking up to her, and before she could ask him for change, he emptied out his wallet into her hands—\$235! She looked down in amazement at all the money, and when she looked up, he was gone. To this day, the couple cannot explain this miracle, other than to say it was an angelic visitation. Anita and Raj kept the dollar bill they arrived with as a memorial of God's faithfulness.

Raj and Anita have both paid a huge price to follow the path that God has set for their lives. Still, their heart burns to see the captives set free. They continue to see miracles as Raj finishes his second year of preparation at CFNI (after receiving another one year scholarship), gaining the training he needs to return and bring freedom to their home country of India. 🇮🇳

The vision of CFNI founders Gordon and Freda Lindsay was to impact humanity with the gospel of Jesus Christ. They founded the Institute to fulfill this vision by training men and women and sending them into every part of the world. Since 1970, students from 99 countries have been equipped for ministry at CFNI. In Fall 2016 alone, CFNI has 325 international students representing 67 countries, including Kyrgyzstan, Tanzania and Vietnam. **CFNI alumni can be found in every time zone of the world doing exploits for God: pastoring**

churches, building orphanages, feeding the hungry and preaching the Good News to people from all walks of life.

Every semester, the Institute grants over 100 scholarships to international students, who otherwise can't afford studying here. Can you imagine being called to CFNI but not having the funds to attend? The International Scholarship Fund helps people all over the world answer the call of God on their lives and be trained to change their nations.

Since 1970, students from 99 countries have been equipped for ministry at CFNI.

Each scholarship is funded by friends and partners of CFNI who see and understand the impact of attending school at CFNI for even one year. One of the ways CFNI presents the vision and need for scholarships is through a golf tournament.

500 YEARS OF REVIVAL

On Oct. 31, 1517, Martin Luther nailed 95 theses to the door of a church, stating his objections to the corruption in the Catholic Church and how it embraced things like indulgences (buying salvation for loved ones). This one act changed the course of human history and began the Reformation.

At CFNI, we trace our spiritual lineage back to Martin Luther, and we recognize that the Church is where it is because of the courageous actions of this one man. This coming year, 2017, we celebrate the 500th anniversary of one of the most important events in Christian history. Yet, we know that it is important not to just celebrate this anniversary, but to help keep the revival fires burning both personally and as a ministry.

The Reformation that Martin Luther started was just the beginning of 500 years of awakenings and revivals. From the First Great Awakening to the Second Great Awakening, the Azusa Street Revival to the healing revivals, and then the Charismatic Renewal, there have been many moves of God, bringing people closer to Him and His purposes. We are now on the cusp of another Great Awakening,

Once we have our eyes turned to God, Gordon Lindsay gives us his prescription for bringing revival. do it." So pray, yes. But don't forget to do the things God has already said. CFNI Co-founder Freda Lindsay declares that revival depends on following just one pattern of ministry. "You can turn your country upside down for God, if you follow the ministry of the Lord Jesus." As we read the scriptures and find out what our Savior did, we will be able to move forward and do what He calls us to do.

This season requires a response. It is not enough to wish for change, we must be a part of the change we want. We, the Body of Christ, must fight against a lukewarm attitude, complacency and apathy. John Wesley speaks a very relevant word to us in this season. "What one generation tolerates, the next generation will embrace." What are we tolerating in our personal lives, our families, our churches and our communities?

At CFNI, we are committed to seeing revival break out in this season. We refuse to wait for someone else; we are the agents God will use to bring revival. 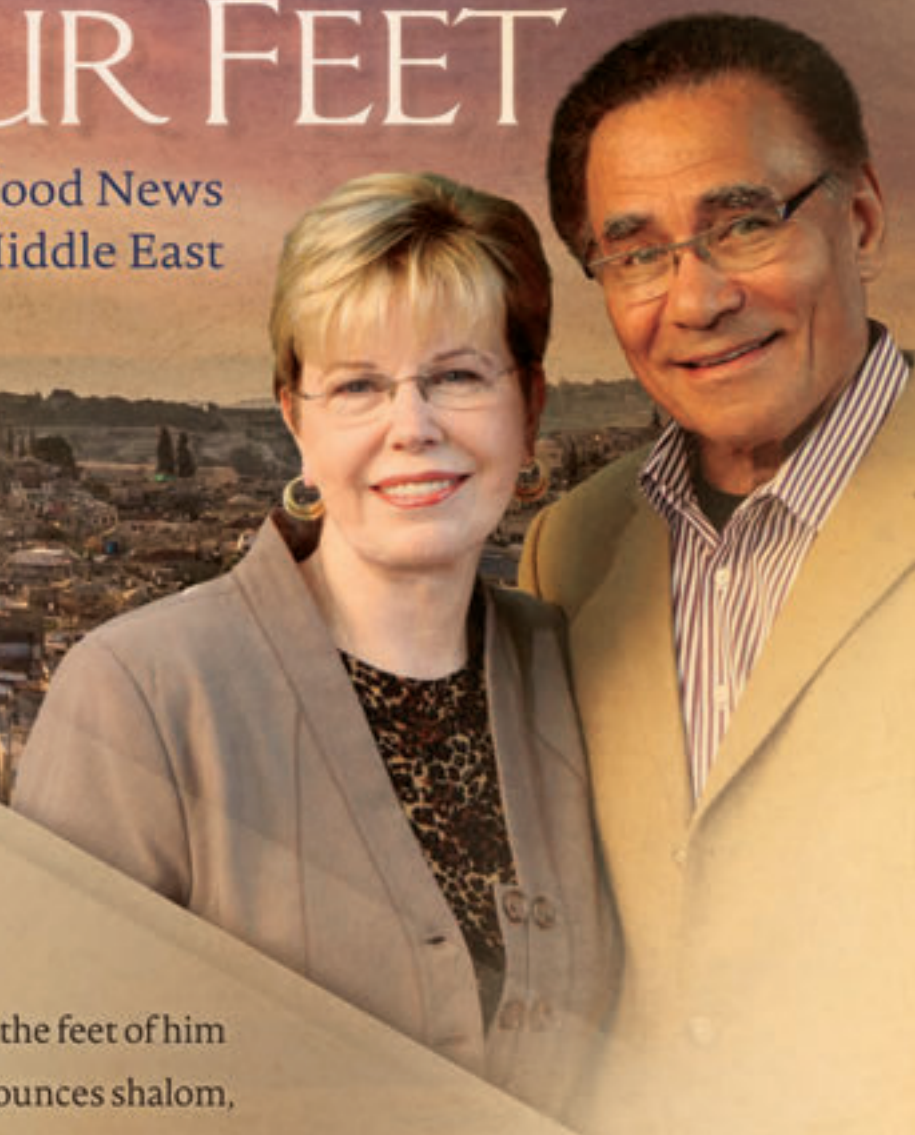
