SPIRITUAL INHERITANCE

I'm blessed. I have an honored and respected family name. I have been handed a well-established ministry. All my life I have been exposed to the power of the supernatural. My parents worked laboriously and sacrificially. My inheritance came at no cost to me. Having served as President and CEO of Christ For The Nations for over 35 years, I realize I have been given the opportunity to bless future students and equip them for the ministry. I have been mentored and trained by a number of spiritual elders, and a General in the Lord's army—my mom.

Now, I am currently mentoring my children who have the legacy, heritage and call to continue serving in the ministry my parents founded. All three of my children were born and raised on CFN's campus, graduated from CFNI and worked for the ministry as they were growing up. I believe I'm preparing them for leadership roles when the appointed time arrives, and they follow in their grandparents' footsteps.

I have come to learn the significance and responsibility of receiving an inheritance and that an inheritance is given freely by someone who has paid a price for it. Likewise, a spiritual inheritance is freely given and received from one's spiritual forefathers. God not only wants to provide us with a spiritual heritage (not having to be earned), but also teach us how to "spend" our inheritance—not on ourselves (for our kingdom) but for building His Kingdom.

Unfortunately, most people who receive a spiritual inheritance from their spiritual parents are not able to take it to another level and pass it on to the generation after them. This is why revival often dies in a short time. Moves of God should not end up fatherless but children should be raised up who receive the inheritance of the anointed mantle and take the move of God to another level. This is my desire with CFN. To do this, one must understand that although an inheritance is freely received, it is paid for by the sacrifice and demanding labor of the benefactor. Likewise, for the beneficiary to take it to another level would require sacrifice and energetic labor, as well as trust and obedience to the will of God.

God wants to cause a spiritual explosion exponentially using children who have received a spiritual inheritance and who will take what they have been given to another level in building the Kingdom of Jesus, rather than soaking up the blessings of the inheritance for personal benefit.

I AM AT THAT PLACE

Now, I am blessed to spend more time with God—praying, writing, teaching and reading His Word. My hobby of Creation Science is blossoming unimaginably. That is what I remember my dad doing every time I went into his room—praying, reading, writing another book or preparing a message.

Legacy is passing the baton to the next generation. Building a bridge for these younger warriors will enable

them to carry on the ministry, to impact their generation for the cause of Christ. I look forward to what God will continue to do at Christ For The Nations with the next generation of leaders. He is “Jehovah Sneaky” yesterday, today and forever, and I say this respectfully. This is what I believe legacy is all about, and why it is strategically significant to pass on God’s initiative to the next generation.

TAKING CFN TO THE NEXT LEVEL

I will build on Dad and Mom’s roof, which they have constructed on the foundational pillars of CFN. They have raised the ceiling of CFN like Elisha did with Elijah. Elisha was not distracted by the supernatural manifestation he witnessed when Elijah was taken up to heaven in a fiery chariot. He continued advancing the Kingdom of God with his generation. I will do likewise. As wonderful as the days were of the healing crusades and miracles that I witnessed as a child, I will not be satisfied. Instead, I made a covenant with God to pick up my parents’ mantle and the spiritual inheritance they left me, and take it to

the next level. I will pass it on to my children to do the same for their generation. To do this I will need partners—those who will come alongside me and help take Christ For The Nations to another level.

PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

If you have not heard of or are not a part of CFN’s partnership program, now would be a good time to answer our call to help this ministry continue to train end-time harvesters for the Kingdom of God by partnering with CFN.

When Dad and Mom began the ministry back in the late 1940’s, they asked for partners who would not only pray regularly for the ministry but also make a commitment to give a monthly donation. This was the key throughout the next several decades as God’s children provided for the financial needs of the ministry. In fact, it has always been the small gifts of the Body of Christ that have sustained the ongoing operation, rather than the occasional large donation. The “widow’s mite” has truly been the bedrock

of CFN's survival. God has used many thousands of faithful friends to meet the ongoing costs with offerings for "where needed most."

Once again we are seeking to revive the partnership program here at CFN and invite alumni and friends of CFN to participate by making a monthly commitment. We know that many of you have given from time to time, especially toward projects. This is commendable and the reason why CFN continues to enlarge its borders around the world. Yet I believe that God wants to once again raise up partners who will make a monthly commitment. Ginger and I likewise give to designated projects from time to time. Now we are following in Dad and Mom's footsteps, making a monthly commitment. Please pray

with us as to what the Holy Spirit would lead you to do. We covet your prayers, friendship, dedicated service and faithfulness to the Lord and CFN. Help us take CFN to the next level of anointing.

A TRIBUTE TO BETH ALVES

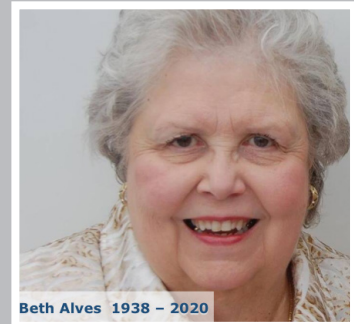

On July 23, 2020, a pioneer in the prophetic and a great general in intercessory prayer, Beth Alves, at the age of 82, ascended into the very presence of God while the song, "It is Well with My Soul," was playing in the background.

Dr. Beth Alves was a friend and partner of CFN for many years. She became Grandmother Lindsay's personal prayer partner, helping her to make strategic decisions and pray through many spiritual battles, while also participating as a member of the CFN Advisory Council. As a great-grandmother herself, she served as a mentor and advisor to three generations of the Lindsay family.

Legendary for her classic bestselling book, "Becoming a Prayer Warrior," Grandmother invited her to become part of CFNI's faculty where she taught "How to Hear God's Voice." This class became the largest elective class in the history of CFNI with well over 500 students.

A leader of leaders, Dr. Beth Alves traveled extensively around the globe to over 40 nations, ministering to business executives, pastors, CEOs, government leaders, and presidents of nations, including multiple U.S. Presidents (from Carter to Bush). Dr. Beth Alves was a member of the Apostolic Council of Prophetic Leaders presided over by Cindy Jacobs, as well as a member of the prophetic and apostolic roundtables with Morning Star Ministries by Rick Joyner. She left a prayer legacy that will never be forgotten. We will greatly miss her.

The explosion felt like an earthquake. It sounded like an atomic bomb and the mushroom ascending cloud seemed to be proof of a terrorist attack. Later, it was learned that 2,750 tons of ammonium nitrate, which Lebanon had seized in 2013 from a Russian crew headed to Mozambique, had exploded. Whether it was accidental or intentional is not known but on Tuesday, August 4, 2020, in the early evening, a portion of Beirut was demolished.

Security cameras captured the force of the explosion and the chaos that occurred at St. George Hospital in Beirut when the blast blew out all the windows in the postnatal ICU wards. One nurse groggily picked herself up and ran quickly to secure the newborn babies and brought them to safety. The prenatal ICU room collapsed as walls and roofs fell but God miraculously saved every innocent baby and left only 17 people killed at the hospital from the explosion. The rest of the city was not as fortunate as more than 200 were reportedly killed and thousands severely injured.

Garbage trucks removing the heaps of waste on the city streets were put on hold as suddenly, all the streets were filled with crisis, chaos and calamity. The flying debris, rubble and ruin blocked most of the roads, while fear ripped the hearts of its citizens. Already a fractured country since the Lebanese Civil War 11 years earlier, the blast added to their economic, spiritual, political and physical woes.

August 4th was also Pastor Chady El Aouad's birthday. Instead of going to his office at Abundant Life Church,

he decided to spend his birthday with family. Before the blast, his staff called and asked him to sign some papers. Although his home was twenty-five miles away, he could feel the blast and thought it was an earthquake. Driving from his home to the church facilities, he witnessed the devastation of the city.

Abundant Life Church is only two minutes from the port where the explosion took place and although God supernaturally protected those in the buildings with no serious injuries, there was severe damage throughout the complex. Pictures of the offices, meeting rooms, the sanctuary and Bible School were sent to us with a request for help.

Shattered glass was everywhere. Furniture was destroyed. Walls and ceilings were affected throughout. The sanctuary seating 500 was in rubble and the main doors were blown off the hinges. Chandeliers fell, air conditioner units were damaged and again, glass was everywhere.



Supernaturally, the staff had only minor injuries but every area of the building was hit. So, what did the church do in such crisis? They sent out teams with sandwiches and food to help those in need.

Because of their compassion and diligence to help the people of Beirut, Christ For The Nations wants to help them rebuild. Pastor Chady has estimated that it will take \$150,000.00 to restore the facilities.


Because of COVID-19, Christ For The Nations' distributions for World Relief have been significant this year. Monies have been sent to: Albania, Pakistan, Congo, Burundi, Ethiopia, India, Kenya, Philippians, Sri Lanka and Zambia but we need your help to assist Pastor Chady and the congregation that worships in Beirut.

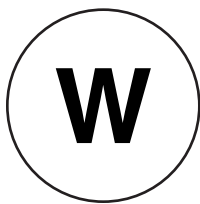

A CALL TO AMERICA

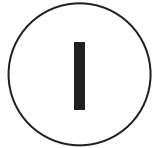

SEVENTY-TWO YEARS OF MISSIONS AT CFNI

In 1955, Gordon Lindsay wrote, “We must have a place where we can train men and women, and show them what it takes to enter a city and take it for God, both here and in foreign lands.” This was part of the vision in 1970. Our vision is to have “an army of trained CFNI alumni fulfilling the mission in every nation.” **Christ For The Nations Institute has trained students for fifty years and our fruit is seen in the lives of our alumni.**

We currently have 92 Bible schools in 47 nations that are making an impact around the world. Last year these schools reportedly trained 5,310 students and they have trained over 63,000 on foreign soil since their combined beginnings. David and Donna Blanchard, directors of Victorious Christian Harvester based in Laredo, TX, are classic examples of how the mission of CFNI is transferred to our alumni. They teach students to invade cities with the gospel of Jesus Christ and provide Bibles to converts. Three years ago, they reached a goal of one million Bibles for one million converts. Today, they have established a new goal: ten million Bibles for ten million converts. In addition to teaching students, they help support national leaders in Cuba, El Salvador and Mexico, and place roofs on homes that have been destroyed. They construct new homes for those in desperate situations and provide ongoing food distribution to the Mexican community across the border from their ministry.

In Acts 1:8, Jesus told His disciples to go to Jerusalem first, then to all of Judea, Samaria and the uttermost part of the earth. We take that Scripture literally and have been supporting various missions in Israel since 1967. In addition, last year, Christ For The Nations helped 28 churches in 13 countries to receive new roofs for their new buildings. Since 1962, we have helped 12,835 churches in 118 countries.

From the time COVID-19 invaded in the Spring of 2020, we have been able to help leaders in Congo, Burundi, Ethiopia, India, Kenya, Pakistan, Philippines, Sri Lanka and Zambia with finances to help starving people affected by the virus. Currently, we support 33 missionaries serving in 23 countries and we also assist 10 orphanages in seven countries. **In addition, we help those who train Native American Indians on U.S. reservations.** The coronavirus stopped all the student outreaches this summer, but we have conducted 384 student outreaches in 92 countries since 1974.

THE FUTURE OF CFNI

WHAT IS CFNI DOING IN TERMS OF 21ST CENTURY DEVELOPMENT?

In light of the uncertain times we are operating in, it is critical that we develop CFNI's campus to incorporate both student-centered design and state-of-the-art facilities that support remote and online learning. We are making a conscious effort to build our campus, programs



and teams around a multi-continent vision to reach the world. Our Dallas campus will be the global hub for training and equipping the leaders of the future to go and take cities for God.

WHY EMBARK ON A DEVELOPMENT PLAN?

Habukkuk 2:2 (ESV) says “Write the vision; make it plain on tablets, so he may run who reads it.” With active vision and a clear path forward we will fulfill the mission of CFNI cast by Gordon Lindsay over 50 years ago. However, training men and women to take cities for God looks different today than it ever has before. Developing a plan to strategically utilize CFNI’s 72-acre campus to carry out that mission through modern methods is our best path forward. Together, with our global network of over 40,000 alumni, we will run with the vision to see the future plans for CFNI become a present-tense reality.

WHAT BUILDINGS WILL BE BUILT?

Together, with our team of architects, engineers and construction experts, we are evaluating every facility on the campus to either receive facade updates or be replaced with new state-of-the-art facilities. You can expect to see a new academic’s building, technical arts & online learning facility, welcome center, student housing, as well as a new 2,000 seat auditorium. This will all be accompanied by an entirely new landscape design featuring walking paths, prayer trails, a new main plaza, lighting and gateway entries all incorporating elements of CFNI’s rich heritage.

WHAT WILL BE THEIR PURPOSE?

Each building will be designed with students, faculty and safety in mind. It’s less about erecting new buildings, and more about facilitating an environment where students can be inspired, equipped, empowered and sent out. When designing each building, we allow the mission, vision and programs of the campus to inform its function and relation to the campus. Greetings Pastor Brown,

I want to share two testimonies with you that occurred about two weeks ago. I logged on to pray with the Healing Place on a Tuesday afternoon for my sister who is battling breast cancer and for **my mother who had just texted to inform me that she was experiencing symptoms of COVID-19** and could not make it to work. He is the same yesterday, today and FOREVER! May every knee bow and every tongue confess that JESUS CHRIST IS LORD! May the name of the Lord be lifted high!!!

My 11 year old son was diagnosed with ADHD about 5 years ago and started taking medicine right away. Even in 5th grade, he was still behind in his classes. The teacher is surprised at how well my son can read/write/spell now. His mind functions as a normal 11 year-old and we are impressed with his behavior. I praise the Lord because I know that He did this.

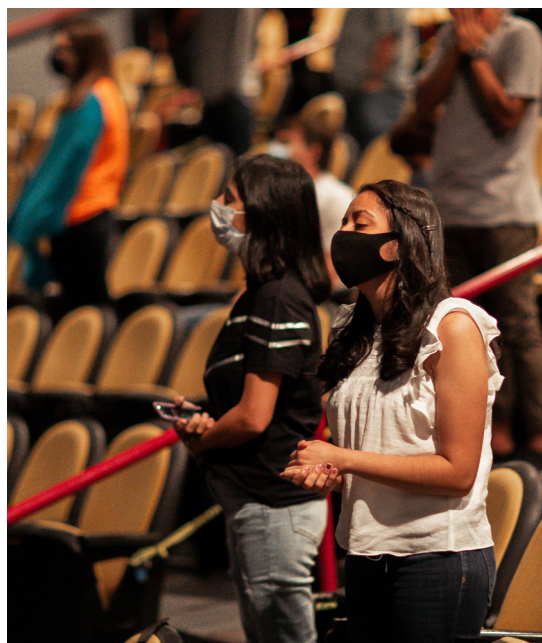
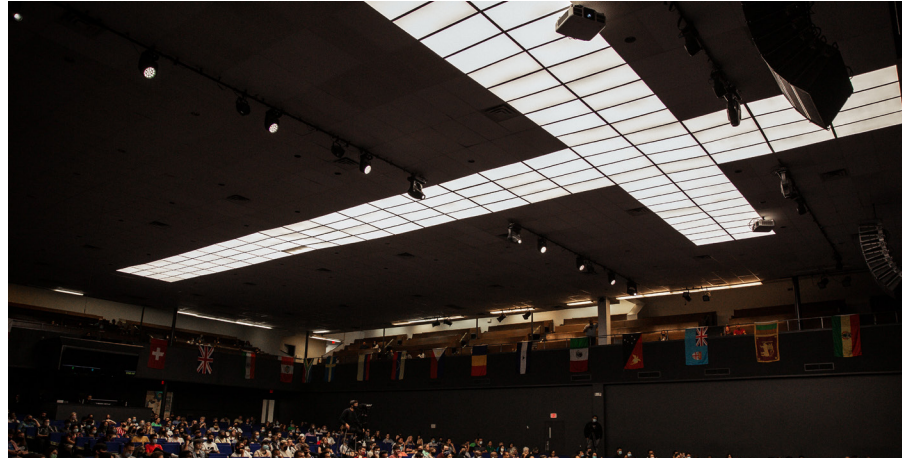
