BETHLEHEM THE BIRTHPLACE OF TRUE LIFE

THE CHURCH OF THE NATIVITY

Bethlehem is about six miles away from Jerusalem or about 15 minutes from the Temple Mount, unless there is a lot of traffic at the border. The Church of the Nativity is the traditional spot where Jesus was born. Bethlehem is no longer just the "little town" of Christmas carol fame. Bethlehem is a busy Arab city. The city sprawls out and is a part of the greater Jerusalem. The Arab market is colorful, and the food is tasty with Arabic cuisine.

Some will be surprised to know that not all Arabs are Muslims. When meeting an Arab Christian, many Western tourists ask when their family became believers in Jesus. The answer is usually, "About 2,000 years ago, back when Jesus' disciples were doing missionary work around here."

IS THIS THE LITERAL SPOT?

Here are some facts about the Church of the Nativity, which is one of the most visited spots in Israel. In A.D. 326, Roman Emperor Constantine sent his mother, St. Helena, to establish the Church of the Nativity. Today, Christian pilgrims wait in a lengthy line to touch, kiss, and pray upon the spot where Jesus is believed to have been born. There is a cavern beneath the church—the Grotto of the Nativity—which is the focal point of one's visit. A silver star in the floor marks the traditional spot where Jesus was said to have been born.

THINK ABOUT WHERE CHRIST WAS BORN

The most significant event in history did not happen at Caesar's Palace. It didn't happen in the ideas of the Jewish political or religious leaders. Christ's birth took place in a manger, a feeding trough for animals. Perhaps it was because He is the Bread of Life. His birthplace was in a town named Bethlehem, which means "bread city."

What

do you think was going through Mary's mind? Emmanuel, God becoming man like one of us, and yet, there were no banners or a welcoming party to receive them when they arrived in Bethlehem.

In fact, there was not even a place in the local inn. Mary was soon to be "ceremonially unclean." The Western image of "no room at the inn" is a brick and wood hotel at full capacity. The "no room" phrase likely meant that a pregnant woman, about to give birth, was not welcomed in the main quarters, because childbirth was considered ceremonially unclean. The solution was an animal shelter. Mary was sent out to the place where they sheltered animals to give birth to Jesus—in a manger. Mary and Joseph and baby Jesus hung out with the animals.

Jesus' life began with rejection. This was the first rejection—one of the many times that Christ was rejected on Earth. Simple shepherds were the first worshipers of the Messiah—the least likely to expect that the Prince of Peace would come to them. They were ceremonially unclean. They were the minimum wage nobodies of the day.

The Jewish Talmud states, "Give no help to a heathen or to a shepherd." Shepherds? This truly is a wonder that God would ordain

> shepherds to be the first who came and worshipped the Christ. On this night, the shepherds were favored by Heaven.

So, why not the theologians? If the angels had visited the theologians of that day,

would they have first turned to to their commentaries? What about the politicians?If they had visited them, would they have looked around to see if anyone was watching?

What about the successful? If they had visited the successful, they would have had to look at their calendars to see if they had time?

The Father sent angels to the shepherds, who did not have a reputation to protect, an axe to grind, and no ladder to climb. God comes to people who have the simplicity of faith to believe Him much like little children whom Jesus spoke about saying, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these" (Matthew 19:14, NIV).

THE TRUE MEANING OF CHRIST'S BIRTH

Christ's birth is about the Creator. It is about Jesus invading humanity. It is about the Savior, the Messiah of the world, the Sovereign of history. It is about the Son of God coming from the Tribe of the Lion of Judah. Christ's birth was contrary to the laws of life. His death was ugly and gruesome. He was rejected again and again. He wrote no book. Yet, after 2,000 years, He is the One central figure of human history.

When the Christ child was born, history was divided in half. Whether one is a believer or not, we all still date our letters, checks and income tax forms with a number that represents how many years have gone by since that life-changing event happened in Bethlehem—His birth.

Likewise, when one is born again, the most significant date of our lives revolves around that day when Christ became our Savior. This is the real wonder of the holiday we celebrate as Christmas. It's when each of us partakes of the Bread of Life and we are born again in our hearts. The result is a continuation of the story of creation in our own personal lives. Through Christ, we have also become new creations.

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new"

(2 Corinthians 5:17, NKJV).

Let Christ into your heart this Christmas and receive the ultimate plan God has always had for you from the foundation of the world from creation. And receive the best gift ever given to mankind—His Son, our Savior, Jesus Christ.

CFNI HEALING SCHOOL OF MINISTRY TESTIMONIES

Junia Passos-

"My 11-year-old son was diagnosed with ADHD about 5 years ago and started taking medicine right away. I always knew that the Lord was going to heal him, but I ended up accepting that disease and was stagnated. I started the healing class in June, and after hearing the encouraging teachings, right from the beginning, I stopped giving excuses and took a step of faith. <u>We repented before the Lord for accepting the diagnosis, rebuked the spirit of infirmity and started declaring the Word to him.</u> The signs would try to come back but every time we rebuked it in Jesus' name. Before he couldn't go one day without his medicine; he'd be completely out of control. We threw the medicine out, and today, 08/13/2020, he is medicine free. He had such a huge difficulty in reading and writing that his 2nd grade teacher recommended him to take a test to see if he had Mental Slowness Disorder which we refused. Even in the 5th grade, he was still behind in his classes. Now, he is surprised at how well he can read/write/spell. His mind functions as a normal 11-year-old, and we are impressed with his behavior. I praise the Lord because I know that He did this."

Doris Barton-

"I've had pain in my right knee for a few months. I went to the doctor about three weeks ago and my doctor diagnosed me with having knee bursitis, which is inflammation of a small fluid-filled sac (bursa) situated near your knee joint. She told me I would need to get a sonogram and depending on the results would probably need to have the bursa drained. I was looking to schedule it in the near future—but God had other plans! On 9/19, while watching the healing films, I was praying about the pain in my knee. <u>I soon felt a very warm feeling radiating from the foot up to my knee ...</u> No more pain ... I WAS HEALED!!!! Bless The Name of The Lord!!"

It was astonishing to hear how many people told us that it wouldn't work, teens won't be as engaged, they're tired of screen-time, you're doing too many sessions, no one wants a virtual camp, just regroup and focus on next year. To be honest, there was no way of knowing if they were right or not, until we did it. Now, on the other side of this historic event, I can say that not only did it work, but teenagers aren't tired of screen time, if it is taking them into a deeper hunger for Jesus!

We saw engagement grow to over 900 streamers across multiple states and nations throughout all thirteen sessions, not to mention the countless lives that were touched through being broadcasted on Daystar TV network. Speakers such as <u>Robert Madu, Benny Perez</u>, <u>Christy Johnson, Dustin Bates</u> and many others joined us from all around the world to pour into a younger generation.

Even though the building here was empty, there were bedrooms, living rooms, and church auditoriums that were full! It was remarkable to see pictures and hear testimonies of the hundreds of youth who encountered God, despite the distance.

This year also marked the 30 year anniversary of this ministry, and I couldn't think of a better way to celebrate 30 years of innovation, pioneering, power, deliverance, breakthrough, and legacy than to see God take YFN to places that it had NEVER been before. We're 30 years young and still have ground to take.

2020 MARDI GRAS OUTREACH

Matthew 10:7-8 says, "As you go, preach, saying 'The Kingdom of God is at hand.' Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give."

In the midst of uncertain times, we can rest in the unshakeable hope we have in Jesus Christ! I am excited to share with you the results from our CFNI Mardi Gras 2020 Outreach in the city of New Orleans. We thank God for a safe and successful trip. Hundreds recommitted their lives to the Lord and were plugged in to local churches this year—only a few days right before the pandemic! America is being saved!

Mardi Gras means 'Fat Tuesday' in French and is a festival that started in the early 1800's. It is the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday, kicking off the 40-day journey of Lent for the Catholic Religion. This is the largest festival of the year. Mardi Gras is a Louisiana state holiday, and New Orleans celebrates it during those days. Multitudes of tourists from around the world pour into the city to celebrate and party for weeks, leading up to Mardi Gras (Fat Tuesday).

The CFNI Mardi Gras Outreach is an annual short mission trip where young adults see their faith stretched, passion provoked, and their love for the lost ignited. It's a five-day outreach in New Orleans, where we experience radical change in the lives to whom we minister the Holy Spirit. Our lives are also being transformed, as we pursue Jesus and share Him with those around us in the streets! CFNI Mardi Gras Outreach is dedicated to spread the love of Christ to all those who were participating in the festival.

Here is the great report of our 2020 CFNI Mardi Gras Outreach:

- Souls hearing the gospel of Jesus Christ and receiving prayer: 651
- Total students and CFNI alumni/staff preaching the Gospel: 106
- Salvations: 345
- Rededications: 65
- Healings: 40
- Baptisms in the Holy Spirit: **13**





Read some of their powerful testimonies.

Mardi Gras was absolutely amazing and life changingtaking me out of my comfort zone and throwing me into a place of really relying on Holy Spirit to move, which was not easy with the distractions and demonic oppression. But breaking through that barrier and seeing God touch the hopeless and broken was worth it. There were two Hindu women who came up for dream interpretations. The lady next to me spoke about the dream, but I felt strongly to ask if they knew Jesus. They told me "Yes," but didn't believe. Holy Spirit then told me to ask if one of their wrists were hurting, and it was. I prayed over it, and she was healed right there. The woman was in awe of what had just happened and her friend was astonished. They just walked away, but I knew that was the moment

the Lord encountered them. The seed was planted, and they had a glimpse of the man we call Jesus.

Brandon Hollar PRACTICAL PASTORAL MINISTRY

There are many facets of pastoral ministry. Pastors do so much more than preach on Sunday morning. The Greek word for pastor *poimēn* means shepherd. This means that the pastor is involved in the care of the people who God has given him/her oversight of. This care includes weddings, funerals, baby dedications, hospital visitations, etc.



Gabriel Castagno NEW TESTAMENT SURVEY

This course focuses on a general overview of the New Testament canon. Our textbook study provides insights as to how the political, religious and social elements in a first century context inform the NT writings, as well as dealing with issues of authorship, dating, and book outlines. The course lectures are devoted to a book-bybook (some shorter books may be grouped together) study, noting thematic messages that are transcultural and transgenerational.



Suzan Bozarth JOSHUA/JUDGES

This course is an inductive study that uses three skills: observation, interpretation and implementation of the books of Joshua and Judges. This is accomplished by looking into the historical background setting and the main messages embedded in each book. Key themes that are integrated throughout are the topics of courage, conquest and inheritance.



Laura McKee PASTORAL CARE AND COUNSELING

This course offers practical tools to develop care counseling ministries and curriculums within the church, including how to identify and equip lay leaders for leadership roles within the pastoral care field. The course also explores theological perspectives on suffering, walking with believers through healing from guilt and shame and how to manage self-care for counselors and ministers.

When you enroll in the online program, you'll earn the same degrees that are offered on campus:

Certificate of Biblical Studies

Associate in Practical Theology Advanced Studies Diploma

Bachelor's in Practical Ministry

We also have **courses in Spanish** for the first year online program, and we recently created the **Spiritual Enrichment Program** for those who aren't degree minded, but want to be equipped with the Word and teachings CFNI offers. Online students also get to experience: Chapel worship, Interaction with fellow students, and Interaction with their instructors.

TRIBUTE TO DR. JOHN HOLLAR

A portion of Old Testament history, recorded in 2 Samuel 3, states that Israel was in the middle of a civil war. The house of Saul battled against the house of David, but they both fought a common enemy, the Philistines. Abner was a general under Saul with a single mission, to transfer Saul's kingship to David, so that David would rule both the northern and southern tribes and all of Israel would become one. Together, they would defeat the Philistines. When General Abner was killed, David fasted and lamented at his funeral and boldly proclaimed to the people, "Do you not realize that a prince and a great man has fallen this day in Israel?"

A thousand years later, the King of Glory was also killed at the hands of his enemies. Jesus came to earth for three reasons:

- (1) To preach the gospel of God's Kingdom -Luke 4:43
- (2) To destroy the works of the devil -1 John 3:8
- (3) To give his life as a ransom Mark 10:45.



At His crucifixion, even His enemies announced, "Surely this was the son of God."

In this generation, another warrior and leader came to Christ For The Nations. Dr. John Hollar enrolled as a student in 1976 and graduated two years later. After earning an Associate of Arts Degree in Practical Theology from CFNI, he preached and taught the Gospel of the Kingdom throughout the United States and around the world, battling the forces of darkness with a message of faith that changed lives wherever he preached.

Dr. Hollar served as a Presbyter of CFN Fellowship of Ministers and Churches (CFN FMC). He led an apostolic network called, The Five Conference, which consisted of about forty churches. He also received a Doctor of Divinity Degree from Life Christian University.

Dr. Hollar was employed at Christ For The Nations on August 21, 2000, as the Dean of Families. During his ministry at CFNI, he also served as the Director of Development and was a member of Dr. Lindsay's President's Council. He was the third director of the Association of Bible Schools between 2012 and 2013, and he served as the fifteenth Director of the Institute from 2014 through 2018. In the same year, John was elected by his peers as Employee of the Year and was considered a favorite teacher among the students.

On October 22, 2020, another prince and great man passed into eternity. John Hollar graduated to be with the saints in glory. He was surrounded by family and his beautiful wife, Ann, who said it best, "He has fought the good fight; he finished the race; he kept the faith." John now awaits his crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge will award him on that day, but not only John, it is for all who long for His appearing. (1 Timothy 4:7-8.)

John and Ann Hollar looked to Charles Neiman as their pastor, who officiated the family gravesite ceremony in Oklahoma. On October 31st, commonly known as Reformation Day, the family conducted a celebratory service on the campus of Christ For The Nations Institute. John Hollar was a prince and a great man. He was loved by all and will truly be missed.

A PARTNERSHIP THAT I



In the mid 80's I was working a decent job and both my wife, Sandra, and I were serving faithfully in our local church. The Lord had been working in us, but we felt God wanted to do more. We sought the counsel of spiritual leaders and they recommended Bible school. So in 1987, we sold or gave away almost everything we owned, packed up our two young children and moved more than 1,000 miles to Dallas as newly enrolled students at CFNI.

The steady flow of international students, guest speakers from around the world, and missions' leaders opened our hearts to the nations. I took John Garlock's *Missions* class and Sandra took Larry Hill's *Practical Preparation for Missions*. We each realized for the very first time that whole nations remained untouched with a witness for Christ, and that if God so chose, he could use us to make a difference in those nations. All that God was doing came together when Don Sims spoke for Mission's Emphasis Week. Don was a CFNI graduate, a protégé of Wayne Myers and one of the founding members of Go To Nations (formerly Calvary International). If Christ For The Nations was the launching pad to missions, then Go To Nations was the vessel that would carry us.

We soon found that CFNI and GTN were already working closely together all over Latin America. Several CFNI grads held significant roles with GTN and regularly returned to Dallas to extend the call to the nations and recruit future missionaries. Don was on his way to Asia to expand GTN's reach around the world. A move that would also expand CFNI's reach deep into Asia.

We finished at CFNI in 1990 and joined Go To Nations

that Summer. By the Spring of 1991, we were living in Manila, Philippines, and were a part of the leadership team for GTN's first Bible School in Asia. To be honest, it was pretty tough in those early years. There were several days when we felt like quitting, but Sandra would say, "We learned in missions class, this is just culture shock." I often heard myself saying, "They didn't teach me everything I needed to know about missions at CFNI, but they taught me to fast, pray, and hear from God until we understood our spiritual authority and began to advance." So we stayed.

Over the next couple of years I became the Bible school director, then the team leader, and by 1994 I was the regional director for all of Asia. Deep in my heart, I carried a passion and understanding for the nations that CFNI put there. As I came to know GTN as a ministry, I found it to be the embodiment of the mission, vision and

values of CFNI. At a core level, they were and are one in the same, CFNI as the sending body, and GTN as the goer. GTN equips and mobilizes emerging spiritual leaders in every nation where we work. With over 24,000 Bible school graduates, we see one new church plant for every two graduates. Nations are being changed!

As I grew in leadership, I would return to CFNI to speak whenever I could, just as those before me had done, to extend the call to the nations and recruit future missionaries. By the late 90's, almost every significant team or ministry leader we had all over Asia was a CFNI grad. They each carried a passion and vision for their nations that was and continues to be relentless. GTN continues to recruit heavily at CFNI and has worked together to provide internships and apprenticeships that prepare graduates for success in missions and fulfill school requirements.

It is our belief that "whatever is born of God overcomes in this world." Both CFNI and GTN are born of God with a mandate to have an eternal impact in the nations. We have a God Who ordained DIVINE PARTNERSHIP. TOGETHER our future will be far more significant than our past.

I am Brooke Hernandez. I'm a planner. When my husband and I got married, we planned on waiting a few years before expanding our family, but in September 2017, God said it was time. I began to pray for our baby.

The first month the test was negative. I thought, "It's okay. Most people don't get pregnant their first try." But month after month with the same report, I laid shattered in bed as tears rolled down my cheeks. Within the first three months of me trying, eight women announced they were pregnant at my church. I started to feel forgotten as all my soon-to-be momma friends' bellies grew and mine remained empty. My feeling of being overlooked by God only intensified as the months began to pile up ...

Almost two years passed and still no baby. All my symptoms pointed to endometriosis, so I chose a fertility doctor who specialized in that. I needed answers. We decided not to tell anyone about this.



Two weeks before my appointment a prophet came to our church. He asked me to stand up and started to speak to my womb. <u>He told</u> <u>endometriosis to leave and told my womb to</u> <u>open. My faith was revived! I knew that God saw</u> <u>me. He knew my pain. He knew my desires, and</u> <u>He granted my healing.</u>

I still went to my fertility appointment. My doctor, through the exam, said my hormones were perfect, so no more tests for a month. Two weeks later I flippantly took a pregnancy test— "Pregnant." Life had filled my womb. I was a mom. In a moment all my deepest desires were a reality.

My husband and I called the long list of people who had been praying for us to tell them the good news. After the last call, we both sat at the foot of our bed, with tears streaming down my cheeks, I told my husband, "Every ounce of pain I felt in my waiting was worth the joy I've felt today."

Our perfect, healthy baby girl was born on April 16, 2020. She lit up the world from day one. She is a physical representation of God's faithfulness. <u>Anytime I see my baby girl, I'm reminded that</u> <u>God heals, God hears, and God gives the best</u> <u>gifts.</u>
