Israel Became A Nation in 1948 Ongoing Spiritual and Natural Battles

THE HISTORY OF THE CONNECTION

It is obvious how the Holy Spirit has led our family into connecting CFN with Israel. My parents, Gordon and Freda Lindsay, and my sister in 1948, actually heard the live, radio broadcast announcing the birth of Israel as a nation. After hearing this, my sister, Shira, immigrated to Israel, married Ari, a Jewish American, began their ministry, MAOZ, raised their family in Israel and have resided there for over 50 years. Gordon and Freda visited Israel many times throughout the years, and Ginger and I have continued ministering for over 40 years. God truly has placed His love for Israel in the Lindsay family's hearts.

DAD HAD A NEW REVELATION

Both the American and Israeli flags have always flown side-by-side on our headquarters building, as well as on the stage in the auditorium. The students are taught the importance of supporting Israel. Every year there is a Bless Israel week where our guest speakers focus on Israel. There are also other guest speakers throughout the year who speak on the importance of Israel for the church and global affairs. Our students are taught that if you understand what God is doing in the land of Israel, then you will know what He is doing in the world. CFNI is all about encouraging the students to pray and support the Israelis.



FRONTLINES ISRAEL PRAYER ROOM

Our love for Israel has continued to grow. In 2015, although we already had the GLHOP (Gordon Lindsay House of Prayer) on campus, we needed an additional place for our students to pray. A vacant storage room was available, and I felt the Holy Spirit lead me to name the consecrated area "Front Lines Israel Prayer Room." The completed project is truly a divine signature from our Lord and indicative of our love for Israel. In the room there is a Western Wall patterned after the Western Wall in Jerusalem. Students can pray and insert their prayer requests in its cracks and between the seams of the blocks of rock, just as it is done at the Western Wall in Jerusalem. It has become a place of prayer, not only for our students, but for our staff as well. CFN loves Israel and its people, and we pray for the peace of Jerusalem. (Psalm 122:6).

AN AMAZING, DIVINE CONNECTION

Israel is the only country in the world that bears the same name, speaks the same language, upholds the same faith, and inhabits the same land as it did 3,000 years ago. Never in the history of mankind has there ever been a nation without a government, army, industry or land that rose up after it was destroyed. CFN owns a three-story, ministry center in Jerusalem on Bethlehem Road the very road it is said that Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, David, Mary, Joseph, Jesus and His disciples walked on between Jerusalem and Bethlehem. It is also said that maybe even the wise men, who were led by the star, were on this road from Jerusalem to Bethlehem.

Since President Donald Trump moved the U.S. embassy from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem in 2018, we sensed God was about to release His Spirit among the Jewish people as a nation to finally become acquainted with their Messiah—Yeshua.

"It's My home,' says the Lord, "For the LORD has chosen Jerusalem; He has desired it for His home. 'This is My resting place forever,' He said. 'I will live here, for this is the home I desired'" (Psalm 132:13, 14).

CFN'S FUTURE

The word of the Lord interrupted the agenda of a meeting in Virginia. The spirit of prophecy broke out in the room: "A million women will gather to the National Mall in D.C. in the hour of our greatest crisis. It will be a 'Last Stand' for America! They'll come in the spirit of Jeremiah 9, 'Call the wailing women—for death (social and moral) has climbed through our windows!' When they come, they will give birth to a great awakening, and they will save the nation."

Heaven had spoken. It was 2014. This heavenly vision has hovered over us since, as we've waited for the fullness of time.

Then, in 2017, witches around the globe rose up to curse President Trump. You have to wonder about a man and his purpose when witches rally against him. My spirit was so agitated by this worldwide assault, that I felt compelled to seek the Lord in prayer. In the mountains of Estes Park, Colorado, I had an unforgettable dream: It was an open field and as far as the eye could see women were coming from everywhere to hear from the book of Esther. The atmosphere was electric with revival. My prayer partner and I were the only men there. He handed me an old Bible, which I now understand to represent the ancient calling of Mordecai (along with many others) to make way for this Esther Movement. In the dream, a woman stood up to teach the book of Esther. She spoke emphatically, "These two words in the book of Esther actually mean Nazgul!"

I exploded out of the dream knowing what it meant. There's a scene in The Lord of the Rings where the Nazgul Witch-king is destroying the armies of men. The armor-clad princess confronts him with her sword as the Nazgul threatens, "No man can kill me!" Just then, she rips off her helmet, lets down her hair, and pierces the Nazgul while declaring, "I AM NO MAN!"

Immediately, I understood that there's coming a mass women's movement of Esthers in the spirit of revival who will wield spiritual authority to restrain the demonic powers behind ideologies threatening to destroy our children and nation. This does not preclude men, but the Spirit is emphasizing the strategic role of women in this hour. Esthers and Mordecais must arise.

Around the same time, unbeknown to us, a business woman named Jenny Donnelly was also being apprehended by the word of the Lord to rally a million praying women. Jesus radically saved my life when I was 18 years old, and I came to CFNI to study three weeks later. I knew after I got here there was no turning back. I am currently in my 6th semester.

My whole life was flipped upside down at the age of eight. I lost my father due to suicide and soon afterwards my mom became a drug addict. We were consistently in the foster care system, going from our mother's home to our grandparent's home. A few years later, my mom gave up her rights to take care of me and my siblings. Fortunately, for us our grandparents adopted us. It was a blessing because later Mom went to prison.

In my high school years, I began to party a lot, and I eventually became heavily addicted to vaping, pornography, and so much more. I struggled heavily in my mind and suffered depression and suicidal thoughts. I was placed in a mental hospital multiple times, but I can see now how the Lord protected me.

My family and I moved to Louisiana right before Covid, and we began to go to a church there. I became curious about the Lord, but was still following my own way. <u>The youth pastor at the</u> <u>church asked me if I wanted to go to CFN Youth For The Nations summer camp in Dallas, Texas</u>. At first, I was hesitant, but my sister was going to go. So I decided to join my sister, and we went to YFN right after my graduation. <u>This is where the Lord radically saved my life</u>.

I remember the preacher prophesying over me, telling me things about my life that I had never told anyone. I knew that God was real. I went back to my seat, and I spoke to the Lord. I told Him that if He was real, and if He wanted to do something with my life, He needed to show me. So, I gave Him my life and began to speak in tongues soon after. Even though I didn't know anything about the Lord or the Bible, I knew I was supposed to apply at CFNI. I did—and I was accepted. Miraculously I was on campus, and my life has never been better.

About 10 years ago, I heard about CFNI for the first time. For me it was impossible to come to study here because I did not have the economic resources, so I gave up that dream. Over the years, some friends came to CFNI. It was through their friendship and paying my enrollment fee, that they showed me they believed in the dream that God had placed in me to come here. It was then that I started this adventure with God and applied for a scholarship. It was a long waiting process that lasted a little over two years, but in the end, God had a plan and a purpose for me at CFNI that resulted in a full, 1-year scholarship.

Before leaving Mexico and coming to study at CFNI, I went through difficult trials, but God sustained me. When I came here, it was hard to adjust at first because it was my first time in the United States, and leaving everything was difficult. However, since being here, I have seen God's hand at all times. I have seen

think one of the areas in which God has transformed me without a doubt is in understanding what my true identity is as His child and walking in that assurance. He has stretched my faith and taught me to learn to depend on Him in everything, knowing that I take the step, and He lays the foundation. At CFNI, God's presence is a reality in every step I take, every day is different, no two are alike. I am deeply grateful to CFNI for the opportunity it has given me to be able to come here to be trained, transformed and sent to fulfill God's purpose to be a world changer.

In December, 2022, my son purchased a plane ticket for me to come and visit my cousins, who are CFNI graduates and live on the campus. My children and family members knew that attending a Bible college full-time has always been a dream for me. While I was on campus, many people on and off campus encouraged me to attend this college. This was my first time visiting Dallas, Texas, and I found it to be a beautiful place. However, I told them I have a job and my children and grandchildren were back home. In February 2023, my son knew I enjoyed my time in Dallas, and he again purchased another plane ticket for me to return to celebrate my birthday on CFNI's campus.

My cousin, Patrice, suggested that I come and attend the college. I told her I would love to come, and I would pray about it, but I did not see me coming to

this school soon. I was just cleaning my bathroom and <u>I heard the voice of the Lord so clearly say.</u> "Daughter, I have released you to go to CFNI." I knew it was God speaking, I dropped the broom, crying profusely and ran to get my phone to call my cousin to tell her the good news. I did not care about how this was going to work out with my job, finances, and leaving my children and grandchildren because I knew God's desire is my desire, and He would provide. All I knew is that I heard God speak, and I was going to be obedient.

I submitted my application to CFNI and received a reply within a week, thanks to my Advisor Alexander Nicholson. I attended Campus Days in April 2023, to visit and get a tour of the campus. I later resigned from my job, packed my bags and moved to CFNI in August 2023. What God did for me He can and will do for you, just BELIEVE!

The scripture the Lord gave me is Matthew 19:29, "And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or fields for my sake will receive a hundred times as much and will inherit eternal life."

In the August 2004, Voice of Healing magazine, the release of the new CD *Glorious* was initially introduced. They knew it was highly anointed but didn't realize the impact this CD would have on the world. So now it only seemed appropriate that we would celebrate it's 20-year reunion with our alumni, staff, friends, and our Savior Jesus Christ.

It was the incredible Holy Spirit-filled worship sessions during chapel that inspired Golan Lindsay to host all-day worship encounters each semester. The *Glorious* celebration and the allday worship were the perfect match. So on February 16, 2024, we had— "ENCOUNTER."

We had guest worship leaders like, Martin Smith, who for the last three decades, has been writing songs that bring fresh air to the lungs of the Church. From "Did You Feel the Mountains Tremble?" and "Waiting Here for You" to "I Could Sing Of Your Love Forever" and "History Maker," Martin's songs have connected generations and inspired and influenced worship leaders and worshippers alike.

Many of our alumni also came to lead worship—Zach Neese, Walker Beach, Kristen Takape, Jonathan Lewis, Eddie James, Rachel Tuttle, Klaus Kuehn, David and Alena Moore, along with the CFN Worship team.

So many of the songs on the *Glorious* CD went around the world. One of the most renown was *Revelation Song* by Kari Jobe. Some of the others were, *No Sweeter Name, The More I Seek You, My Romance,* and *Running.*

CELEBRATING 20 YEARS OF "GLORIOUS"

As newlyweds, Suleman Manzoor and his wife, Tina, came to CFNI as scholarship students. Both of them agree that this was the greatest wedding gift they could have ever received! Their marriage and their ministry got the best start and greatly benefitted from the two years they spent at the school. The Lord also entrusted them with starting the all-night prayer at CFNI where many students' lives were empowered.

Suleman was born and raised in Karachi, Pakistan. Although he wasn't saved until the age of 17, he grew up witnessing many miracles. His father was a great man of faith, whom the Lord used in the healing and deliverance ministry, which often took place in their home. Therefore, signs and miracles were an early part of Suleman's daily life and also became a natural part of his ministry, once he accepted the Lord.

Tina told us that Suleman rarely does anything halfheartedly. In fact, most would consider him pretty radical, especially in his pursuit of God's intervention in critical circumstances. He strongly believes in persistent prayer—to the point that it moves God to respond to the relentless request of the supplicant. When Suleman has a pressing need, he simply prays around the clock—without ceasing until something happens—or God shows him it's not time. He acts like—and often preaches about—the persistent widow, who would not leave the unrighteous judge alone until she got his attention, and he granted her favor.

Upon graduating from CFNI's pastoral class of 1997, Suleman and Tina sought the Lord in prayer and fasting about their future. Although they were asking for specifics, they perceived the Lord calling them to "the nations," which was soon made evident in their ministry. They felt led to return to Sweden, Tina's

homeland, and in 1999, they founded the ministry of RAPHA Mission. *Rapha* is Hebrew, and it means healing and restoration to spirit, soul, and body.

The very first mission for RAPHA was a healing campaign in Suleman's home city of Karachi in Pakistan. <u>He was reluctant to return to Pakistan</u>, <u>being well aware of the resistance and challenges of the Islamic nation; but he heard the Lord and obeyed</u>. A large plot in the center of the city was prepared with all the essentials the campaign would require—stage, sound system, chairs, and carpets. But the day before it was to start, the city council revoked their permission! Suleman then cried out to the Lord, Who miraculously enabled him to arrange another arena and move the entire event overnight! <u>This first campaign brought over 6,000 souls into the Kingdom of God, and the line of people testifying of being healed and delivered seemed to never end</u>.



In August of 2001, RAPHA Mission prepared to open an office in Afghanistan. Suleman planned to go to Kabul (the capital) and take a team with him, but then the 9/11 terror attack took place with a terrible war following. Many fled Afghanistan, and welfare organizations evacuated their personnel. Suleman also thought he should cancel all his plans to reach into Afghanistan, but once again received the Lord's rebuke. While in prayer, the Lord asked him, "Who told you to go there in the first place?"

"You did, Lord," he replied. "Am I not able to protect you?" the Lord asked. Then Suleman felt ashamed. Realizing that the Lord had not changed His mind, he went. As a result, RAPHA Mission was able to help thousands of refugees with relief, and present Jesus to many who were now in the refugee camps.

The Lord asked Suleman to not start a base in Kabul, but in Kandahar-a violent city in a region known for its terrorist training camps. So, he went to the border city of Quetta in Pakistan and requested to see the Afghan ambassador. Fervent prayers allowed him to meet the ambassador with whom he received favor beyond his imagination. The ambassador wrote a letter of recommendation to the governor of Kandahar, who provided Suleman and his team with an army escort across the border! Needless to say, the lack of funds was a huge concern. However, in this daring mission, the Lord used Mrs. Freda Lindsay at Christ For The Nations. She did not know what was going on with us, but she was prompted by the Spirit to call us. When she heard that Suleman was at the Afghan border ready to move in, she sent a check for \$10,000 U.S. to support the mission.

Over the years, the miracles RAPHA Mission experienced were amazing. They helped dig hundreds of water wells in villages around Kandahar. <u>After an</u> <u>eight year drought, Suleman prayed with a bottle of</u> <u>anointing oil over the land and broke the curse. Rain</u> <u>came</u>! After that, we prayed for rain many times. Suleman was the one they reached out to for help. We received videos, months after the prayers, showing us the gushing waters and refilled dams, which only proved to the people how faithful God really is.

RAPHA Mission has continued to spread the Gospel all over the world, primarily in countries in Asia and South America. <u>Signs and miracles confirm the truth of the</u> <u>Word when Suleman preaches with healing being a</u> <u>strong evidence of the love and care the Lord has for</u> <u>each individual</u>. However, the main field for us has been Pakistan, where about 96 percent of the population are Muslims. The country has suffered many catastrophes, including earthquakes and floods. We have risen to the challenge of helping people with relief. Most recently, our teams have worked intensely to help the more than 33 million people affected by the disastrous floods through distributing food packages, drinking water, and tents.

When Suleman's father passed away, he left a piece of land to him, which has been used to facilitate a Godgiven vision of an orphanage—Manzoor Orphan House. Ten years later, a second orphanage was built and opened. The two orphanages provided a home for about 60 children, who all go to Christian schools. In addition, RAPHA Mission leads a prayer center and three schools for children. The Mission has also helped a congregation build a church building and start satellite churches.

Yet, as amazing as these testimonies are about God's requests to him, the one that shocked him the most was when he asked, "Lord, how can I reach them with the Gospel?" God said, "Use Santa Claus!" "But I do not even believe in Santa Claus," Suleman objected! The Lord then reminded him of how He used an unclean bird to feed his servant Elisha. Suleman then understood that Santas could be effective in using Christmas presents that contained Gospel materials. Who would not—out of sheer curiosity—watch a Jesus movie, if given one for free?

That's how the Christmas Parades, officially being peace manifestations, started in Karachi. While playing praise and worship music and praying over the establishments along the road, trucks, camel carts, motorbikes, and other vehicles made up the



train of thousands of Santas, making their way through the main city streets. Originally, most of the pastors did not embrace the idea—being fearful. However, we are to have the mind of God and not be motivated by fear. There have been attempts of terror attacks against the parades, but they have been exposed and defused. The Lord is able to shut the mouths of the lions because of our obedience.

Suleman continues to testify: "Prayer is the most powerful weapon in the world!" Throughout his Christian life, he has seen the Lord make a way where there seems to be no way. He has learned to look upon human impossibilities as possibilities for God to show Himself strong and mighty. When people say, "It is impossible," his response is that "Everything and anything is possible for God." The result is significant: No man can take the credit—God gets all the glory.

This description of Mardi Gras, after all these years, has remained the same. It is still a scene of concentrated and deliberate public depravity. However, CFNI is just as determined today to go and show the love and power of God as they did then.

It all began in the late 1970's when CFNI sent a van load of students to witness on the streets of the French Quarter in New Orleans during Mardi Gras, and it still continues today. Mardi Gras is a 40-day celebration religious in its origins that at times has drawn a million people coming from all over the world to get crazy, drunk, naked, weird and insane. Scott Hinkle

Throughout the years our students (at times over 200) have gone to share the Gospel with great results. Preparation is absolutely essential. Prayer, fasting, and practical training to successfully minister in this unique setting takes place weeks in advance. The 2024 CFNI team of 45 students and staff were part of an overall team of 105, who I had the privilege to lead. Each day these spirit-filled emissaries of "Good News" would break out into teams and invade the city. It's been an honor for me to be a part of this all of these years through the Scott Hinkle Outreach Ministry. I am a CFNI alumni, CFNI instructor and a veteran evangelist.

As believers we know the light works best in darkness. Bringing the good news to the throngs of those who love to party in New Orleans presents students with the great opportunity to see the Holy Spirit work through them supernaturally in a situation that might not seem conducive to ministry ... BUT IT IS! They get to experience being used by God in a powerful way.

Westpoint Church in Gretna hosted the team for meals and meetings, bringing together a strong, local partnership in reaching out to the city. As the team prayed and believed God for divine appointments, they would personally engage with people from so many backgrounds. Some would be searching for something. Others would be running from something in their life.

Overall, in just three days of ministry outreach, the power of prayer combined with their soulwinning action resulted in 1,482 people being ministered to and prayed for individually for many different needs—including salvation, healing, re-commitment, and much more.

Beyond that, an outdoor Prayer/Praise Rally was held in the midst of it all on the riverfront where we saw nearly 1,500 people crying out to God for the city.

This outreach provided students with an opportunity for God to use them to reach broken and hurting people in an ungodly atmosphere, which helped in preparing them for their future ministry.

The van load of CFNI students who first chose to go to New Orleans from the late 70's gave birth to CFNI's "GO." They also began the continued outreach to this city many times over.
